Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 15-1/2" squares centered on each of the panel's motifs

From each of Fabrics B-G, cut:

one 15-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 15-1/2" square of each fabric

From each of Fabrics H-K, cut:

seven 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 2" x 15-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

two 2" x 18-1/2 rectangles of each fabric

two 2" x 21-1/2 rectangles of each fabric

From each of Fabrics L-O, cut:

six 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2" x 15-1/2" rectangles of each fabric

eight 2" x 21-1/2 rectangles of each fabric

From Fabric P, cut:

three 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty eight 2" x 2" squares

From Fabric Q, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Sew the strips together, then subcut:

two 2-1/2" x 84-1/2" side inner borders

two 2-1/2" x 67-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From the remaining of Fabric C, cut:

nine 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, then subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 88-1/2" side outer borders

two 5-1/2" x 77-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Note: Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on page 6 for the specific fabric combinations used in our sample quilt.

Step 1: Gather:

- one 15-1/2" square for the block center (Fabrics A-G)
- four Fabric P squares.
- four 2" x 15-1/2" rectangles for the inner round of the block. These four rectangles should be cut from the same fabric (Fabrics H-O)
- two 2" x 18-1/2" and two 2" x 21-1/2" rectangles for the outer round of the block. These four rectangles should be cut from the same fabric (Fabrics A-G)



Step 2: Sew one 2" x 15-1/2" Fabric H rectangle between two 2" Fabric P squares. Press toward the rectangle.

Make two H/P units.

Step 3: Sew two 2" x 15-1/2" rectangles for the inner round of the block to the left and right edges of the center square. Press towards the rectangles.



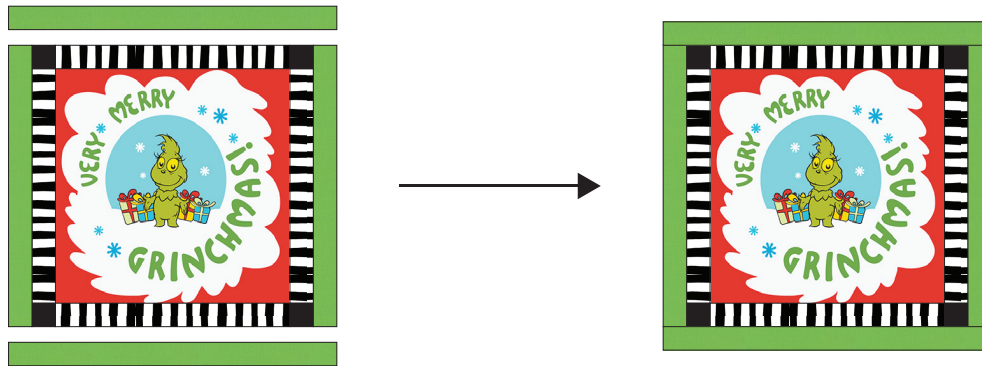
Step 4: Sew the two H/P units for the inner round of the block to the top and bottom edges of the unit. Press towards the newly added rectangles



Step 5: Sew the two 2" x 18-1/2" rectangles for the outer round of the block to the left and right edges of the unit. Press towards the newly added rectangles.



Step 6: Sew the two 2" x 21-1/2" rectangles for the outer round of the block to the top and bottom edges of the unit. Press towards the newly added rectangles to complete the block. Block should measure 21-1/2" x 21-1/2".



Step 7: Repeat Steps 1-6 to make twelve blocks in the fabric combinations shown on page 6.

Assemble the Quilt

Step 8: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the block placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 9: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the block placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 10: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

Step 11: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 12: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
